WAGE RATE – “Gross Earnings” to which the 51.0931% contribution rate is applied includes straight time hours at \$43.00, time-and-a-half hours at \$64.50 and double-time hours at \$86.00. **PLEASE NOTE:** Foreman and general foreman premiums, of \$3.00 and \$6.00 respectively, are **NOT** included in “Gross Earnings” for EIT contribution purposes.

ANNUITY PLAN – This \$4.42 per hour is a non-taxable fringe benefit and is **not to be included in taxable wages nor in “Gross Earnings”**.
