GIVE THIS TO THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR PREPARING YOUR PAYROLLS AND PAYROLL TAX RETURNS

Pursuant to Section 18.01 of Article XVIII of the Principal Agreement, the Trustees have allocated contributions as follows effective with payroll reports filed for June 6, 2016 through June 4, 2017. This change reflects a \$2.25 increase in the total wage and fringe rates.

¹**WAGE RATE** – “Gross Earnings” to which the 53.2321% contribution rate is applied includes straight time hours at \$46.10, time-and-a-half hours at \$69.15 and double-time hours at \$92.20. **PLEASE NOTE:** Foreman and General Foreman premiums, of \$3.00 and \$6.00 respectively, and vacation fund amounts are **NOT** included in “Gross Earnings” for EIT contribution purposes.

²**HEALTH & WELFARE** – EJAB has broken down the contribution for informational purposes into \$10.61 for active coverage and \$3.72 retiree coverage based upon 2015 EIT claim history.

³**VACATION FUND** – This newly negotiated hourly taxable fringe benefit amount should be accounted for separately with a corresponding deduction from each employee’s gross wages. Employers will send these deductions **directly** to the Great Lakes Credit Union. Information regarding payment details will follow from EJAB.

⁴**NEBF** – This contribution is made separately. **It should NOT be sent to Electrical Insurance Trustees.**
