## GIVE THIS TO THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR PREPARING YOUR PAYROLL AND PAYROLL TAX RETURNS

Pursuant to Section 8.06 of Article VIII of the Residential Agreement, the Trustees have allocated contributions as follows effective with payroll reports filed for June 5, 2017 through June 3, 2018. This change reflects a \$2.55 increase in the total wage and fringe rates.

<sup>1</sup><u>WAGE RATE</u> – "Gross Earnings" to which the 51.9831% contribution rate is applied includes straight time hours at \$47.40, time-and-a-half hours at \$71.10 and double-time hours at \$94.80. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Foreman and General Foreman premiums, of \$3.00 and \$6.00 respectively, and vacation fund amounts are <u>NOT</u> included in "Gross Earnings" for EIT contribution purposes.

<sup>2</sup><u>HEALTH & WELFARE</u> – EJAB has broken down the contribution for informational purposes into \$9.99 for active coverage and \$4.34 retiree coverage.

<u><sup>3</sup>VACATION FUND</u> – This hourly taxable fringe benefit amount should be accounted for separately with a corresponding deduction from each employee's gross wages. Employers will send these deductions <u>directly</u> to the Great Lakes Credit Union.

<sup>4</sup>NEBF – This contribution is made separately. <u>It should NOT be sent to Electrical Insurance Trustees</u>.
